

ROXBURY BOARD OF ABATEMENT
MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 27, 2018
6:03PM - 6:22PM

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chuck Slocum, Dave McShane, Gerry D'Amico, Jeremy Reed, Adam Jackson, Sue Nevins, Anne Maxham and Tammy Legacy

The meeting was called to order at 6:03PM by Gerry D'Amico.

Scott Jenkins and Heather Codling took an oath.

Scott Jenkins is requesting an abatement of his current and delinquent taxes. His property is located at 541 East Roxbury Road in East Roxbury.

The reasons for the request for abatement are:

- Scott Jenkins has a serious medical condition that occurred in May of 2018.
- Scott has not worked since May of 2018.
- Scott does not know when he will be able to go back to work if at all.
- Scott was in an accident on May 22, 2018 that made his condition worse.
- Scott has no income coming in.

Scott explained that he was a mechanic and is unable to work. He is currently going through therapy. Scott showed the Board his medical records.

Heather Codling explained that she had to give up her full-time job to be Scott's caretaker. She is currently working part-time.

The Board wished Scott luck with his recovery. Scott and Heather left the meeting at 6:14PM.

The Board entered into deliberations at 6:14PM.

The Board exited deliberations at 6:21PM.

Chuck Slocum moved to abate the taxes of Scott Jenkins for the years 2017/2018 and 2018/2019. The motion was seconded and passed with all in favor.

The tax amounts that are abate are:

2017/2018 - Principal \$363.99, Interest - \$1.83, Penalty \$29.12 = \$394.94

2018/2019 - Principal \$659.84, Interest \$1.64 = \$661.48

No other abatement requests were brought to the Board so the meeting adjourned at 6:22PM.
