 - iii. Sprint OK’d the site
 - c. Looking for person/company to build path & place gravel. Jim to touch base with NU on who they might recommend.
 - d. Fence – Ed handed out page of fence options.
 - i. Milled Stockade chosen
 - ii. 6’ X 8’, perhaps 10 sections needed
 - e. Enlisting Volunteers
 - i. Path placement
 - ii. Plants
 - iii. Looking to set a meeting in May 12th to finalize on planting placements. Some plants to be donated. Several “plant experts” will be asked to discuss plantings.
